■ **First Ever National Air Sports Policy Announced**

Union Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia announced the National Air Sports Policy-2022 in New Delhi on 6th June. The objective of this policy is to include India among the top air sporting nations by 2030 by promoting safe, affordable and sustainable air sports ecosystem in the country. Eleven air sports including Aerobatics, Ballooning, Gliding, Parachuting, Powered aircraft and Rotorcraft will be promoted through this policy. Speaking on this occasion, Mr. Scindia said, this will help in generation of one lakh jobs in the sector and increase the revenue from existing 100 crore rupees to 10 000 crore rupees in coming years.
