

■ PM Launches News Schemes for MSMEs during Udyami Bharat

The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) organized *Udyami Bharat* programme on the occasion of International MSME Day and grand finale of Enterprise India Campaign on 30th June, 2022 in New Delhi. On the occasion, PM Shri Narendra Modi
