■ President of Maldives Concludes 4-day India Visit

President of the Maldives Ibrahim Mohamed Solih was on a four-day visit to India during which he held a one-on-one discussion with Prime Minister Narendra Modi and met with other politicians, bureaucrats and industry leaders. Six agreements/MoUs were exchanged covering



various areas of cooperation including capacity building & training of members of Local Councils and Women Development Committee of Maldives, collaboration in potential fishing zone forecast capacity building and data sharing and marine scientific research between, cooperation in the area of Cyber Security, cooperation in the field of disaster management, agreement between India's EXIM Bank and Maldives' Ministry of Finance, for USD 41 Million Buyer's Credit Financing of Police Infrastructure in Maldives. Additionally, India has announced extension of USD 100 Mn new Line of Credit to finance infrastructure projects in Maldives.
