## ■ Queen Elizabeth II of Britain Dies after Reigning for 70 Years

Queen Elizabeth II, Britain's longest serving monarch, has died at 96. She reigned for 70 years. Her eldest son, Charles, 73, has succeeded as King. The

Queen was born Elizabeth Alexandra Mary Windsor, in Mayfair, London, on 21 April 1926. As per reports, the Queen's last public engagement was with the UK's new Prime Minister Liz Truss at Balmoral Castle on September 6. During the meeting, the Queen asked Truss to form a new administration and appointed her the PM and First Lord of the Treasury.
