Indian Railways Clocks 38 Percent Revenue Increase

The overall revenue of Indian Railways at the end of August 2022 was Rs 95,486.58 cr, showing an increase of Rs 26271.29 cr (38%) over the corresponding period last year. The revenue from passenger traffic was Rs 25,276.54 cr with an increase of Rs 13,574.44 cr (116%) over the corresponding period last year. The other coaching revenue was Rs. 2437.42 cr, showing an increase of Rs 811.82 cr (50%) over the corresponding period of last year. This development is fueled by robust growth in the Parcel segment of Indian Railways. Goods revenue was Rs.65,505.02 cr by August this year, an increase of Rs 10,780.03 cr (20%) over the corresponding period of last year. This has been achieved through incremental loading of more than 58 MT and 18% growth in the NTKMs during the period. Food grains, fertilizer, cement, mineral oil, container traffic and other goods segments have been important contributors in this growth, in addition to coal transportation. The sundry revenue was Rs 2267.60 cr. showing an increase of Rs 1105 cr (95%) over the corresponding period of last year.
