Redevelopment of Delhi, Ahmedabad, Mumbai Railway Stations to Create
New Jobs

The Union Cabinet has approved Indian Railways' proposal for redevelopment of three major railway stations in the country - the New Delhi Railway Station, Ahmedabad Railway Station and Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus in Mumbai. According to Railways Minister Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw, the redevelopment work of three railway stations will be completed in two to three and half years at an estimated cost of Rs 10,000 crores. The redevelopment of Delhi, Ahmedabad and Mumbai Stations will help in the creation of at least 35,000 new job opportunities, the Minister added.
