Australian Parliament Ratifies Free Trade Agreement with India

The Australian Parliament has approved the Free Trade Agreement (FTA) between India and Australia. In a message to his Australian counterpart Mr. Anthony Albanese, Prime Minister Shri. Narencra Modi said the agreement will further strengthen the India-Australia Comprehensive Strategic Partnership. Meanwhile, Commerce and Industry Minister Shri.
