India Clinches 5 Medals at Asia Junior Badminton Championship

Indian shuttlers clinched three silver and two bronze medals at the Asia Junior Badminton Championship, held in Nonthaburi, Thailand. Top-seeded young shuttler Unnati Hooda won silver in the Women's Singles Under-17. With this, she has become the first Indian to enter the Under-17 women's singles final at the tournament. Anish Thoppani secured a silver medal in the Men's Under-15 Singles. Indian under-17 men's duo Arsh Mohammad and Sanskar Saraswat also clinched a silver medal. Tankara Talasila of the Under-15 Men's Singles and Under-15 Men's Doubles pair Bjorn Jaison and Aathish Sreenivas secured a bronze medal each in their respective events.
