■ MEA Warns Against Overseas Job Scams The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) has issued a cautionary advisory on fraudulent overseas recruitment, urging job seekers to use only registered Recruiting Agents. The advisory highlights a surge in scams involving fake job offers and overcharging by unregistered agents, operating through platforms like

Facebook and WhatsApp. These illegitimate agents often subject workers to dangerous conditions. The MEA stresses the importance of seeking information from reliable sources, such as Pre-Departure Orientation Training Centers or the Indian Embassy's Community Welfare Wing. The government mandates registered recruitment agents to provide Pravasi Bharatiya Bima Yojana, offering benefits like a Rs. 10 Lakh sum assured for death cases and coverage for work-related injuries and medical expenses with a one-time premium.
