■ PM Launches Ambitious Welfare Initiatives for Tribals in Jharkhand

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi launched two historical initiatives. Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra and Pradhan Mantri Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups Development Mission, in a programme marking the celebrations of Janiativa Gaurav Diwas in Khunti, Jharkhand on November 16. Announcing the schemes worth Rs 24,000 crores, the PM highlighted that the Centre has increased six-fold the budget for tribal welfare.
