India's Total Food Grain Production Estimated at Record High of Over 3.2 Lakh Tonnes



The total foodgrain production for the country has reached an estimated record high of approximately 3,297 lakh tonnes, according the Ministry of Agriculture. This marks a substantial increase of about 141 lakh tonnes compared to the previous year's foodgrain production figures. The Ministry further reported that rice production for 2022-23 is estimated at around 1,350 lakh tonnes, wheat

production at approximately 1,100 lakh tonnes, and total pulses production at roughly 260 lakh tonnes. Minister of Agriculture Shri Narendra Singh Tomar attributed the growth to the government's effective implementation of agricultural schemes and programmes, and the collective efforts of all involved in the agricultural sector.
