■ Global Maritime India Summit 2023 Unveils India's Maritime Blueprint for Amrit Kaal

The Global Maritime India Summit 2023 held in Mumbai, unveiled a blueprint for India's maritime future, 'Amrit Kaal Vision 2047,' setting the stage for a new era of development and growth in the country's maritime sector. This visionary document seeks to enhance port facilities, promote sustainable practices, and facilitate international cooperation, charting a course for India to become a prominent player in the global maritime community. Among the notable projects aligned with this vision is the Tuna Tekra all-weather deep draft terminal, strategically located to serve as a gateway for Indian trade via the India-Middle East-Europe Economic Corridor (IMEEC).
