

■ Government Increases LPG Subsidy per Cylinder by Rs. 100 for Ujjwala Yojana Beneficiaries

The Government has increased the LPG subsidy per cylinder by Rs. 100 for the Ujjwala Yojana beneficiaries. Briefing the media in New Delhi on October 4, Union Information and Broadcasting Minister Shri Anurag Singh Thakur said that in a major decision, the Union Cabinet approved an increase

in LPG subsidy, raising it from the current Rs. 200 per cylinder to Rs. 300 per cylinder for the beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana. Shri Thakur informed that the Union Cabinet also approved terms of reference to Krishna Water Dispute Tribunal-II under the Inter-State River Water Disputes Act, 1956 for its adjudication between Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. He said, that the resolution of the dispute will open new avenues of growth in both the States. He also said, the Government has also approved an amendment to the Central Universities Act, 2009 for setting up of Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University in Telangana.
