

■ Indo-Pacific Armies Chiefs Conference Emphasises Regional Cooperation and Stability



The Indo-Pacific Armies Chiefs Conference (IPACC), Indo-Pacific Armies Management Seminar (IPAMS), and Senior Enlisted Leaders Forum (SELF)-2023, a three-day event organised by the Indian Army in collaboration with the US Army, successfully concluded in New Delhi. Attended by delegates from 30 countries, including Chiefs of Armies and Heads of Delegations, the event served as a platform for the exchange of ideas and discussions on security and mutual interests. During the opening ceremony, Defence Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh emphasised the untapped potential of the Indo-Pacific region, underlining India's commitment to a free, open, inclusive, and rules-based Indo-Pacific. The event sought to address critical themes such as sustainable peace and security, cooperation for enhanced interoperability, and Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR).
