

■ G4 Nations Reiterate Call for UN Security Council Expansion

The G4 nations, comprising India, Brazil, Japan, and Germany, have restated the necessity for expanding the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) in both permanent and non-permanent categories to enhance its representation, legitimacy, effectiveness, and efficiency.

During a meeting on the sidelines of the 78th Session of the United Nations General Assembly, Foreign Ministers from Brazil,

Germany, Japan, and Sanjay Verma, Secretary West, External Affairs Ministry, jointly emphasised the strain on multilateralism caused by complex global crises.
