Indian Women's Blind Cricket Team Clinches Gold at IBSA World Games

The Indian women's blind cricket team secured a gold medal at the IBSA World Games by defeating Australia in the finals by 9 wickets. Despite rain interruptions, the Indian women's cricket team showcased exceptional resilience. In their match against Australia on August 20, they restricted the Australian team to a total of 59/6. India efficiently chased down the target, winning by a margin of eight wickets. In their subsequent encounter with England, the Indian team delivered a remarkable performance, amassing a total of 268/2 in just 20 overs. India continued their reign of dominance by resoundingly defeating Australia once again in their third match, held on Wednesday, by a massive margin of 163 runs. Buoyed by their outstanding form, the team advanced to the finals, where they clinched the gold medal.
