Ladakh The Border Roads Organisation (BRO) has embarked on the construction of the world's highest motorable road, named the Likaru-Migla-Fukche road, situated near Hanle in Eastern Ladakh. This 64-km long thoroughfare is set to link Likaru to Fukche, a mere three kilometers away from the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in Eastern Ladakh. The road holds strategic significance, as it will form a crucial axis
