

UK Announces Second Ballot of India Young Professional Scheme

The British government has opened its second ballot for the UK-India Young Professional Scheme, granting young Indians aged 18 to 30 with graduate-level qualifications the chance to live, work, or study in the UK for up to 2 years. The UK-India Young Professionals Scheme visa allows eligible candidates to enter and exit the UK freely within the visa's validity.

The scheme launched earlier this year offers 3,000 places, with most allocated during the first ballot in the month of February. The remaining spots will be randomly selected in the second ballot. Interested applicants must meet financial and other requirements and travel to the UK within six months of applying for the visa.
