

■ Chhattisgarh Gets New Development Projects Worth Rs. 7,600 Crore

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone, dedicated and inaugurated ten projects worth about Rs 7,600 crore in Chhattisgarh's capital Raipur. These include Raipur-Dhanbad and Raipur-Vishakhapatnam Economic Corridor. These projects are mainly related to increasing road and rail connectivity and development of



basic infrastructure. On this occasion, the PM said that today a new saga of development is being written in the aspirational districts of Chhattisgarh, which were once called backward and where violence and anarchy prevailed.
