DGCA, EU Aviation Safety Agency Ink Pact for Cooperation on Drones, Air Mobility

The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has entered into a pact with the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) for cooperation in the areas of unmanned aircraft systems and innovative air mobility. The two watchdogs would cooperate in the areas of development of certification standards, environmental standards and related requirements for the certification and use of unmanned aircraft systems and innovative air mobility operations. According to the Civil Aviation Ministry, the MoU will also focus on regular information sharing between the two authorities on technological developments and research.
