PM Modi and Ex-Japan PM Yoshihide Suga Discuss Global Partnership

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi met the Chairman of the Japan-India Association (JIA) and former Prime Minister of Japan, Mr. Yoshihide Suga July 6 in New Delhi. Mr. Suga was on a visit to India with a delegation of over 100 members.
