American chipmaker Micron will invest \$825 million to construct a Chip Assembly and Testing Facility in Gujarat, India. The total investment, including contributions from Government of India and Gujarat government, amounts to \$2.75 billion. Construction is set to begin this year, with the first phase becoming operational in late 2024. The facility will create up to 5,000 direct jobs and 15,000 community jobs.
