

PM Modi-led Govt Completes 9 Years, Achieves Milestones Across Sectors

The Union Government led by the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) under Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi completed nine years. On this occasion various ministers highlighted the achievements and global recognition earned by India during this period. External Affairs Minister Dr S Jaishankar emphasised

India's role as a development partner and a narrative shaper in the world. In a media briefing, he mentioned India's unique approach during the Russia-Ukraine conflict and its significant contributions during the Turkiye earthquake and Sri Lanka's economic crisis to highlight India's capability as a first responder and its efforts in economic stabilisation.
