India is at the Forefront of Energy Transition: Union Minister R. K. Singh

India has advanced significantly in the field of renewable energy. As highlighted by Union Minister R. K. Singh, India had pledged to obtain 40% of its energy requirements from non-fossil fuels by 2030 but instead achieved this by 2021. nine years earlier. The Minister was addressing a plenary session on 'Renewables - Powering the Net Zero Agenda of India' at the CII Annual Session 2023 on May 25. While



addressing, the Minister also pointed out that the country's demand is rapidly growing, and by 2030, energy consumption is expected to double. "Net Zero is important, but what is more important is that we ensure enough electricity for growth," said the Minister.
