

India and Thailand Joint Trade Committee Agree to Address Market Access Issues

India and Thailand have agreed to address market access issues and technical barriers through sustained bilateral discussions. The 13th Meeting of India-Thailand Joint Trade Committee (JTC) held in New Delhi on 20th April was the first physical meeting of the JTC since it was revived in 2020, following a 17-year hiatus. During the meeting, the two sides reviewed the status of bilateral trade and identified new potential products and priority sectors to expand bilateral trade. India specifically asked for easing of restrictions it faces in exporting marine, poultry, and meat products.
