AAP Gets ECI Recognition as 'National Party'

The Election Commission of India (ECI) has granted 'National Party' status to Aam Aadmi Party (AAP). After its recognition as a 'State Party' in Gujarat, the AAP has become a 'State Party' in four states, namely Delhi, Punjab, Goa and Gujarat, hence it fulfills the eligibility conditions for granting recognition as a 'National Party'. Meanwhile, the All India Trinamool Congress (AITC), Communist Party of India (CPI) and Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) have lost the 'National Party' status. The ECI has granted recognition to Tipra Motha Party as a State Party in Tripura, Voice of the People Party as a State Party in Meghalaya, and Lok Janshakti Party (Ram Vilas) as a State Party in Nagaland.
