■ India Conveys Concerns over Misuse of UK's Asylum by Extremists

On 12th April 2023, the 5th India-UK Home Affairs Dialogue was held in New Delhi. During this meeting, India and the UK reviewed their ongoing cooperation and identified further steps to explore opportunities and synergies in advancing cooperation in various areas. These areas included counter-terrorism, cyber security &

global supply chains, drug trafficking, migration, extradition, and anti-India activities in the UK including pro-Khalistan extremism. The Indian side specifically conveyed its concerns regarding the misuse of the UK's asylum status by pro-Khalistani elements to aid and abet terrorist activities in India. They requested better cooperation by the UK in monitoring of the activities of the extremists and appropriate proactive action. India's concerns over the breach of security of the Indian High Commission were also emphasised.
