

■ 25 SCO Countries Agree to Collaborate on Promoting Traditional Medicines

25 countries from the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) have agreed to collaborate on promoting e traditional medicine and contribute to economic development, environment protection, and health security. The consensus was reached at during the B2B Conference & Expo and National Arogya Summit held in Guwahati under India's presidency of the SCO. The event witnessed the active participation of Myanmar and Maldives health ministers and technical sessions by China, Russia, and Pakistan through virtual mode. The conference was attended by a total of 214 participants, including 83 international delegates from 16 SCO countries and 131 Indian delegates. The B2B expo involved 56 exhibitors and received trade interest from 13 SCO countries in the fields of Ayurveda Education, Traditional Medicine Products, and developing Infrastructure for providing Ayurveda and Yoga for Medical Value Travel.
