India Score 4 Gold in World Women's Boxing Championship

Nikhat Zareen has become the second Indian woman boxer after Mary Kom to bag more than one world titles. Women's World Boxing Championships in New Delhi, 26 year old Nikhat created history as she defeated Vietnam's Nguyen Thi Tam in the 50 light fly weight category. India wrapped up World Boxing Championships with four gold medals. While Tokyo Olympic bronze medallist Lovlina Borgohain won her maiden World Championships gold by defeating Caitlin Parker of Australia in the final of the middleweight 75 kilogram category, Nitu Ghanghas and Saweety Boora also won two gold medals for the country.
