Madhya Pradesh Unveils Policy for Connecting Youth with Employment

In Madhya Pradesh, Chief Minister Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan has unveiled the State Youth Policy and a Youth Portal with the aim to connect the youth with employment. As per the policy, to participate in the recruitment process for all government posts in the state, the examination fee will have to be paid only once. A separate merit list will be made for admission to MBBS and BDS for the students studying in government schools of the State. 5 percent seats will be reserved in colleges for this purpose. Moreover, under the Mukhya Mantri Yuva Kaushal Earning Scheme, an amount of at least Rs 8,000 will be given to the youth every month on the basis of learning and earning.
