

■ G20 Foreign Ministers' Meet Concludes in New Delhi

Leaders from around the world gathered in India for the G20 Foreign Ministers Meeting held on 1st - 2nd March 2023. The meeting focused on achieving common and concrete objectives, with a particular emphasis on the need for resilience in societies, healthcare systems, and economies. Addressing the meeting, Prime Minister Shri

Narendra Modi highlighted the crisis facing multilateralism today, with global governance failing in its mandates to prevent future wars and foster international cooperation on issues of common interest. "Developing countries are particularly affected by this failure, facing unsustainable debt and struggling to ensure food and energy security for their people. India's G20 Presidency is seeking to give a voice to the Global South, ensuring that those most affected by global decisions are heard," he said. The Prime Minister urged the leaders to draw inspiration from India's civilisational ethos and focus on what unites them all.
