- bilateral relations between the two countries.

  India and Australia Sign Agreement on Mutual Recognition of Qualifications
  - India and Australia have signed an agreement for establishing a framework mechanism for mutual recognition of qualifications, aimed at facilitating two-way mobility of young people for education and employment purposes. The agreement covers both education and skill qualifications of the two countries, will create more opportunities for students and professionals, and pave the way for making education the biggest enabler in taking India-Australia bilateral relationship to greater heights. The two countries have also agreed to explore ways of enhancing research and academic collaborations between universities through the mechanism of Joint/ Dual/ Twinning degrees that have been introduced under India's National Educa-

tion Policy 2020.
