

## ■ India Energy Week 2023: Country Showcases its Energy Sector Evolution

India Energy Week 2023 concluded on 8th February in Bengaluru, attracting more than 35 foreign ministers, 500 speakers, 30,000 energy professionals, 8,000 delegates and 700 exhibitors from over 100 countries. The Strategic Conference was successful in bringing together key stakeholders from the integrated energy value chain to share insights on strategies and trends impacting global energy markets, while the Executive Sessions convened leaders at the forefront of business operations to share best practices in pursuing the 'Net-Zero' agenda. The Technical Conference offered engineers and project managers exposure to latest industry expertise. India utilised the event to highlight its initiatives in the energy sector, including efforts to ensure energy security in line with Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's pledge to achieve Net-Zero emissions by 2070. The event also saw the launch of the Global International Biofuel Alliance and several agreements and MoUs, leading to further strengthening of international collaborations and partnerships in the energy sector.
