■ **Rs 2,539.61 Crore Plan Approved for Public Sector Broadcasting Upgrade**

The Union Cabinet has approved a Rs. 2,539.61 Crore plan to upgrade the country's public broadcaster Prasar Bharati's infrastructure, as part of the Central Sector Scheme "Broadcasting Infrastructure and Network Development" (BIND). The BIND scheme will allow Prasar Bharati to improve its facilities and widen its reach, including in the LWE (Left Wing Extremism), border and strategic areas, as well as provide high-quality content for both domestic and international audiences. In addition, Doordarshan and All India Radio studios will be upgraded to be HD-ready. The project has the potential to generate employment in the manufacturing of broadcast equipment and DD Free Dish DTH boxes, as well as in the content production sector.

■ **UGC Issues Draft Regulations for Operation of Foreign Universities in India**

(UGC) has released draft regulations that aim
