UGC Issues Draft Regulations for Operation of Foreign Universities in Mola The University Grants Commission (UGC) has released draft regulations that aim

to regulate the entry and operations of foreign universities in India offering degrees, diplomas, and certificate programs. The draft has been made available to the public for comments and feedback, with a deadline of the 18th January 2023. According to the draft regulations, foreign higher education institutions (FHEIs) must obtain approval from the UGC before setting up campuses in India. In addition, foreign universities must be ranked within the top 500 of global subject-wise rankings as determined by the UGC. A standing committee will review applications by foreign universities considering factors such as the credibility of the institution, the programs being offered, and the proposed academic infrastructure.
