■ Shalini Kumari Receives Top Award at ASEAN India Grassroots Innovation Forum

Shalini Kumari from India received the first prize in the Grassroots Innovation Competition at the 3rd ASEAN India Grassroots Innovation forum for her modified walker with adjustable legs. The technology, which was transferred to the industry leader Vissco Rehabilitation Aids, is now available for purchase in India through Brick and Mortar stores and online marketplaces like Amazon India. Kumari received the cash prize of \$1,500 from the Cambodia COSTI Chairman and Director General at the conclusion of the three-day forum, which featured panel discussions,
