## ABOUT THE BWU LIBRARY

The Brainware University Library serves as a vital knowledge resource center, boasting a vast collection of materials that has recently increased from 38,932 to 42,411 books in last six months. This extensive collection includes books, numerous national and international journals, magazines, project reports, subject dictionaries, fiction and non-fiction works, biographies, rare and valuable texts, manuscripts, career guides, ready reference materials, theses and dissertations, and previous years' question papers. With comprehensive cataloguing and detailed records, students can easily navigate a user-friendly index, Web-OPAC, to find what they need. To enhance user experience, the library utilizes an RFID system for easy circulation and footfall counting, making it more efficient for students and staff to access resources.

Additionally, the Dept. libraries are focused on specific disciplines like Pharmaceutical Technology, Law, Nursing, Allied Health Sciences and Biotechnology. Together, the Central Library and these departmental libraries offer an extensive array of resources. The integrated library system used at Brainware University Library, is KOHA (version 20.11), while the DSpace institutional repository software has been employed to manage and preserve the academic and research outputs of the University.

At that time, books were printed on bamboo leaves and palm leaves in Kolkata within a very short time. The book was probably published at that time (possible year: 1890 - 1910). The book also contains the rules for Durga Puja along with Sri Sri Chandī.

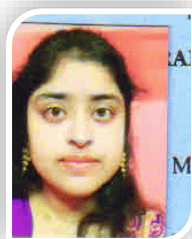

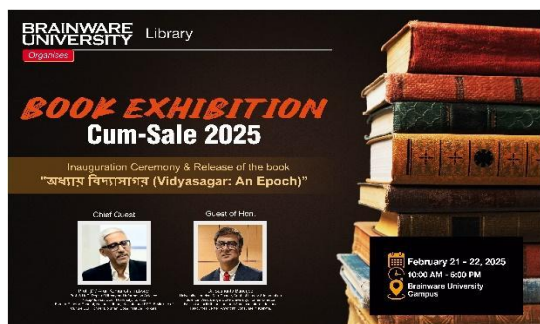

## যোগ ও প্রণায়াম: ইতিহাস, অনুশীলন ও গুরুত্ব



### ইতিহাস:

যোগ (Yoga) শব্দটি সংস্কৃত 'যুজ্' ধাতু থেকে এসেছে, যার অর্থ হলো মিলন বা সংযোগ। এটি শরীর, মন ও আত্মার সংযোগ ঘটানোর এক প্রাচীন ভারতীয় জীবনপদ্ধতি। যোগের উৎপত্তি প্রায় ৫,০০০ বছর আগে ভারতের সিদ্ধ সভ্যতায়। পতঞ্জলি মুনির 'যোগসূত্র' হল যোগ দর্শনের মৌলিক গ্রন্থ। এতে আট অঙ্গবিশিষ্ট যোগপদ্ধতির (অষ্টাঙ্গ যোগ) উল্লেখ রয়েছে — যম, নিয়ম, আসন, প্রণায়াম, প্রত্যাহার, ধারণা, ধ্যান ও সমাধি।

### প্রণায়ামের ইতিহাস:

'প্রণায়াম' শব্দটি 'প্রাণ' ও 'আয়াম' - এই দুটি শব্দের সংমিশ্রণে গঠিত, যার অর্থ হলো "শ্বাসের নিয়ন্ত্রণ"। এটি যোগের এক অঙ্গ, যার মাধ্যমে শ্বাস-প্রশ্বাসকে নিয়ন্ত্রণ করে মনকে স্থির ও শান্ত রাখা যায়। বহু প্রাচীন শাস্ত্রে, যেমন হঠযোগ প্রদীপিকা ও গোরক্ষ সংহিতায় প্রণায়ামের উল্লেখ রয়েছে।

### অনুশীলন:

যোগের বিভিন্ন আসন যেমন পদ্মাসন, তাড়াসন, ভূজঙ্গাসন, সূর্য নমস্কার প্রভৃতি প্রতিদিন নিয়মিতভাবে অনুশীলন করলে শরীর সুস্থ থাকে। প্রণায়ামের মধ্যে অনুলোম-বিলোম, কপালভাতি, ভ্রমরী, উদগীত প্রভৃতি জনপ্রিয়। এগুলি মূলত বসে শান্ত মনে ধীরে ধীরে শ্বাস গ্রহণ ও ত্যাগের মাধ্যমে করা হয়।

### গুরুত্ব:

- **শারীরিক উপকারিতা:** যোগ শরীরকে নমনীয় করে, রক্তচাপ ও ওজন নিয়ন্ত্রণে রাখে, হৃদয় ক্ষমতা বাড়ায়।
- **মানসিক উপকারিতা:** প্রণায়াম মনকে প্রশান্ত করে, দুশ্চিন্তা ও স্ট্রেস কমায়। স্থিতিশক্তি ও একাগ্রতা বাড়াতে সাহায্য করে।
- **আধ্যাত্মিক উপকারিতা:** নিয়মিত যোগ ও প্রণায়াম অনুশীলনে আত্মোপলব্ধি সম্ভব, যা জীবনের প্রকৃত উদ্দেশ্যকে উপলব্ধি করতে সাহায্য করে। শারীরিক স্থিতি ও মানসিক প্রশান্তির মাধ্যমে আত্মজ্ঞানের বিকাশ ঘটে। নিয়মিত অনুশীলনে অন্তর্জ্ঞান জাগ্রত হয় এবং আত্মা পরমাত্মার সঙ্গে সংযুক্ত হয়। এই যোগসাধনাই ঈশ্বর উপলব্ধির সোপান। এটি মোক্ষ বা চূড়ান্ত মুক্তির পথ।

### উপসংহার:

যোগ ও প্রণায়াম কেবল শরীর চর্চার একটি পদ্ধতি নয়, এটি একটি পূর্ণাঙ্গ জীবনদর্শন। এর মাধ্যমে আমরা শারীরিক, মানসিক ও আত্মিক দিক থেকে সুস্থ থাকতে পারি। প্রতিদিন অন্তত কিছু সময় যোগ ও প্রণায়াম অনুশীলন করলে জীবনের গুণগত মান অনেকটাই উন্নত হয়।

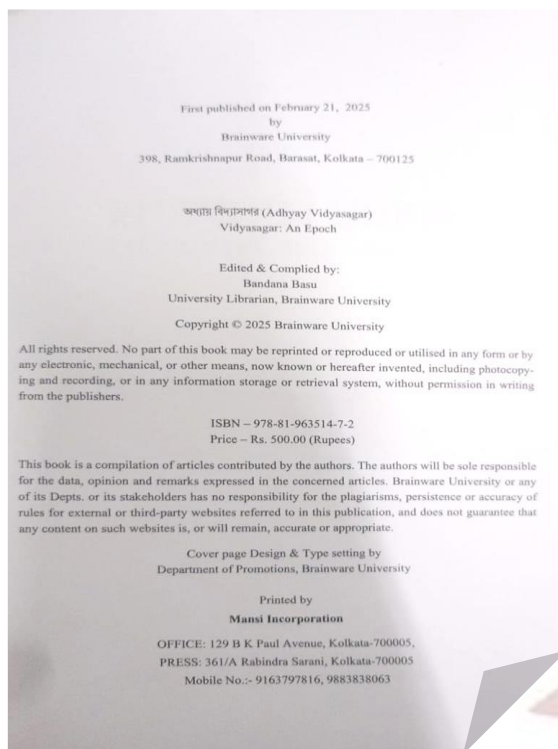
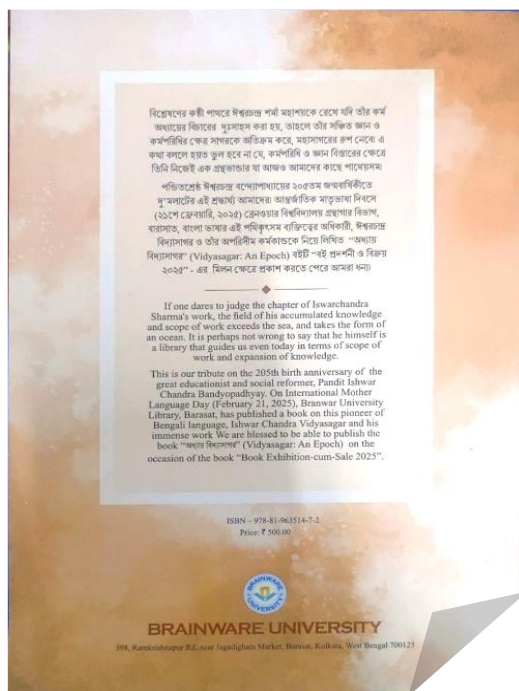
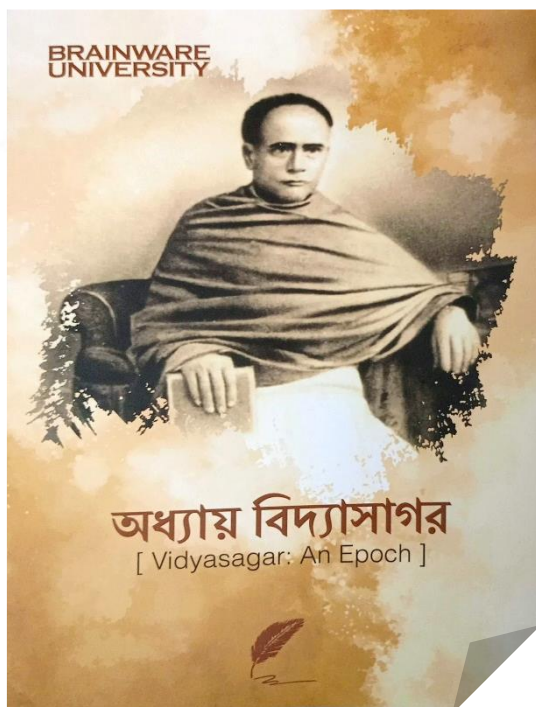
