Meanwhile, the All India Trinamool Congress (AITC), Communist Party of India (CPI) and Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) have lost the 'National Party' status. The ECI has granted recognition to Tipra Motha Party as a State Party in Tripura, Voice of the People Party as a State Party in Meghalaya, and Lok Janshakti Party (Ram Vilas) as a State Party in Nagaland.

Available in 120+ international and Indian languages, it will serve as an aggregator of global content and courses in various domains, and help guide, provide content, and match women with internships and jobs. The framework of the platform was presented and discussed in the G20 EMPOWER meeting held in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala on 5th - 6th April 2023.

# India Conveys Concerns over Misuse of UK's Asylum by Extremists

On 12th April 2023, the 5th India-UK Home Affairs Dialogue was held in New Delhi. During this meeting, India and the UK reviewed their ongoing cooperation and identified further steps to explore opportunities and synergies in advancing cooperation in various areas. These areas included counter-terrorism, cyber security & global supply chains, drug trafficking, migration, extradition, and anti-India activities in the UK including pro-Khalistan extremism. The Indian side specifically conveved its concerns regarding the misuse of the UK's asylum status by pro-Khalistani elements to aid and abet terrorist activities in India. They requested better cooperation by the UK in monitor-



ing of the activities of the extremists and appropriate proactive action. India's concerns over the breach of security of the Indian High Commission were also empha-

## India, Vietnam Reiterate Commitment to UNCLOS to Ensure Free and Open Indo Pacific

India and Vietnam have emphasised the significance of the UN Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS) and reiterated their commitment to resolving any disputes in accordance with international law, rejecting threats and unilateral actions that alter the status quo. National Security Adviser, Shri Ajit Doval held a delegation-level meeting on bilateral security cooperation with Vietnamese Public Security Minister Tô Lâm in New Delhi. In the meeting, both the leaders reaffirmed their commitment to strengthening the Comprehensive Strategic Partnership that aims to improve strategic, security, and defence ties to maintain peace, prosperity, and stability in their countries, the region, and the world. The leaders further reaffirmed the importance of maintaining and promoting peace, stability, maritime safety and security, and freedom of navigation and over-flight in the Indo-Pacific Region.

## Indian Aviation Retains FAA Category 1 Status

India has retained the US Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) International Aviation Safety Assessment (IASA) 'Category 1' status. Notably, air carriers of 'Category 1' countries are permitted to operate or expand their services to destinations in the US and code share with US air carriers. The US FAA under its IASA programme, had conducted an audit of India's Directorate General Civil



Aviation (DGCA) in the areas covering aircraft operations, airworthiness and personnel licensing. The 'Category 1' determination has come at a time when Indian aviation is on a high growth trajectory and air carriers in India have major capacity induction and expansion plans

## India Calls for Increased Global Efforts to Address Growing Debt Distress

Union Finance Minister, Smt Nirmala Sitharaman has underlined the need to increase efforts to address growing debt distress globally. Participating in the Global Sovereign Debt Roundtable Meeting in Washington DC, the Minister stressed the need for debt transparency and information-sharing and clarity on the predictability and timeliness of the debt restructuring process. She added that India is committed to its reform agenda, aimed at creating a stronger and more dynamic economy, overcoming challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic.
