Save it to promote preventive healthcare awareness and emergency preparedness at Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya, Narendrapur, on May 9.

Doctors and educators conducted interactive sessions on stroke awareness, CPR and emergency response. NRVP secretary Shivaji Basu Ray stressed the importance of awareness-driven education in preparing students for emergencies.

Dr Saurabh Kole spoke on public participation during medical crises, while Dr A. Shobana explained stroke symptoms using the FAST approach.

Dr Saswati Sinha addressed antimicrobial resistance. A practical CPR demonstration was conducted by Dr Prithwiraj Saha, Dr Golam Ahmed Mondal and Dr Somnath Mondal, teaching students life-saving intervention techniques during cardiac emergencies.

“Through this programme, the NRVP is trying to take critical life-saving awareness beyond hospitals and into society, so that our students become capable of responding during medical emergencies,” said Basu Ray.
