**1. Give reasons for any five of the following statements:** 5 x 3 = 15

- (I) Oxygen is to be humidified before administering it to the patient [3]
- (II) Preferring autoclaving over boiling of the instruments. [3]
- (III) Use a backrest for a patient having dyspnea. [3]
- (IV) Water to be pushed in the balloon of Foley's catheter. [3]
- (V) Frequent change of position of a bed ridden patient [3]
- (VI) Damp dusting is preferred to dry dusting whenever possible. [3]
