■ A study by the SETI Institute, US, suggests we may be overlooking alien signals because their own stars are scrambling them. Turbulent plasma and powerful stellar storms can spread an ultra-narrow radio transmission across a wider range of frequencies, making it much harder to spot. This is particularly true of M-dwarf stars, which are most common in the Milky Way.
