■ Khelo India University Games

The second edition of Khelo India University Games is being held in Karnataka from 24th April to 3rd May. Approximately 3879 participants from around 190 universities are participating across 20 disciplines vying for 257 gold medals. Two new disciplines namely Yogasana and Mallakhamb have been added for the first time in an effort to preserve and promote the century-old sporting disciplines of the country. Union Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports Anurag Thakur said that the Khelo India University Games (KIUG) will help prepare international level sportspersons as it aims at providing a national-level launchpad for University students to showcase their talent and catch the eyeballs of the team selectors for various sports.
